Drivers whose blood pressure is between 140-159 systolic and/or 90-99 diastolic are medically classified as stage 1... Drivers with a BP of 160-179 ...

Two-year DOT medical certification: A blood pressure reading under 140/90. One-year DOT medical certification: A top number of 140-159 and a bottom number of 90-99. Three-month temporary DOT certification: A top number of 160-179 and a bottom number of 100-109. The attending physician may recommend blood pressure medication, and the driver can be tested again for a one-year

DOT Physical Requirements: Blood Pressure & Drug Tests ...

A CMV driver with a Blood pressure (BP) 140/90 may be certified for 2 years. First time BP elevated: Stage 1 - BP 140-159/90-99 Certification Period 1 year. Stage 2 - BP 160-179/100-109 Certification Period 3 months as one time certification. Within the 3 months, if the blood pressure is below 140/90, the driver may receive 1 year certification. Stage 3 - BP Reading >180/110 Disqualified.

What is the effect on driver certification based on FMCSA ...

When the blood pressure is less than 140/90, the driver can be certified at 6 month intervals. There are reasons the FMCSA has set these stipulations in place for your DOT physical. Driving with high blood pressure is a risk for you, your passengers, as well as other drivers on the road.

What are the DOT physical blood pressure requirements? A DOT driver with a blood pressure under 140/90 may be medically certified for 2 years. If the commercial driver has a top number of 140-159 and a bottom number of 90-99 may be DOT medically certified for 1 year.

DOT Blood Pressure Guidelines | dot physical blood

According to DOT guidelines, a person with diabetes, whether controlled with diet alone or diet plus medication, must meet the following criteria: Maintain a glycosylated hemoglobin (Hemoglobin A1C or "HBA1C") of 10% or less. The HBA1C is a measure of the average amount of sugar in the blood over the last 3 months.

If blood pressure is lowered to below 140/90, then you may be given a six-month certificate and will need to recertify every six months. If you have high blood pressure, it is important to take steps to lower your blood pressure in the short term and in the long term.
