Litmus Paper Test Results

Initially, litmus paper is either red or blue. The blue paper changes to red, indicating acidity somewhere between the pH range of 4.5 to 8.3. (Note that 8.3 is alkaline.) Red litmus paper can indicate alkalinity with a change to blue. In general, litmus paper is red below a pH of 4.5 and blue above a pH of 8.3.

Litmus Paper and the Litmus Test - ThoughtCo

Performing a litmus test is one of the oldest and simplest methods of determining the acidity or alkalinity of a solution. Litmus paper is made when a piece of thin paper is coated by organic dyes that are sensitive to changes in pH. When the dye is exposed to a liquid or gas, it will either react or stay the same based on the pH of the sample.

Since litmus paper gives indeterminate results around neutral pH 7 one has to consider alternative tests in this range. A pH meter is one option but this is relatively expensive and not for recommended for science fair or homeschooling use. pH test strips use different chemical indicators.

When red litmus paper is placed into a basic substance, it will turn blue. If it comes in contact with an acidic or neutral substance, it will remain red. Red litmus paper is meant to test only for an alkaline pH level. Common acids include include tartar sauce, corn, bacon and beer.

The main use of litmus is to test whether a solution is acidic or basic. Blue litmus paper turns red under acidic conditions and red litmus paper turns blue under basic or alkaline conditions, with the color change occurring over the pH range 4.5-8.3 at 25 °C (77 °F). Neutral litmus paper is purple.

The blue litmus will turn red or pink when it comes into contact with an acidic solution below pH 4.5. Between 4.5 and 8.3 the paper will be purple. Above 8.3 it will stay blue. Supplied in plastic vial, about 100 paper strips/vial.

Litmus test papers give qualitative results; i.e. yes or no, acid or alkaline. pH test strips are semi-quantitative. i.e. they tell you how much but with some uncertainty. A pH meter is quantitative with some error. Titration is quantitative and most accurate but is time consuming & can be expensive if done in a certified lab.
